**Action:** Notice of Proposed Assessment of Class II Clean Water Act Section 309(g)(2)(B) and 311(b)(6)(B)(ii) Administrative Penalties and Opportunity to Comment

Under Sections 309(g) and 311(b)(6) of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. §§ 1319(g) and 1321(b)(6), EPA is authorized to assess a civil penalty after providing the person subject to the penalty notice of the proposed penalty and the opportunity for a hearing, and after providing interested persons public notice of the proposed penalty and a reasonable opportunity to comment on its issuance. In Class II proceedings under Sections 309(g)(2)(B) and 311(b)(6)(B)(ii), any person who violates certain provisions of the Clean Water Act may be administratively assessed a civil penalty of up to sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000) per day per violation for each day during which the violation continued, up to a maximum of one hundred eighty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$187,500) for each Count in the Complaint.

Proceedings are conducted in accordance with the “Consolidated Rules of Practice Governing the Administrative Assessment of Civil Penalties and the Revocation/Termination or Suspension of Permits,” found at 40 C.F.R. Part 22 (“Part 22”).

The procedures by which the public may submit written comments on a proposed penalty order or participate in a penalty proceeding are set forth in Part 22. The deadline for submitting public comment on a proposed penalty order is thirty (30) days after issuance of public notice.

Pursuant to Sections 309(g) and 311(b)(6), EPA is providing public notice of the following proposed administrative penalty assessment:

**Description of Business or Activity Conducted by the Respondent:**

Auto recycling yard that provides auto dismantling and scrap metal recycling services.

**Description of Violations Alleged in Complaint:** 1) discharging stormwater associated with industrial activity without authorization under a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (“NDPES”) permit; 2) failing to apply for coverage under an NPDES permit; 3) failing to prepare and implement a Spill Prevention, Control, and Countermeasure (“SPCC”) Plan; and 4) failing to provide the requested information in violation of Section 308.

**Proposed Penalty:** Penalties of up to \$16,000 per violation for each day during which the violations continued, up to a maximum of \$187,500 for each Count in the Complaint.
