



Top 25 K-12 Schools

As of October 25, 2021, the combined annual green power use of EPA’s Top 30 K-12 Schools amounts to more than 101 million kilowatt-hours of green power, which is equivalent to the annual electricity use of more than 9,000 average American homes.
