This program provides \$5 billion to replace the nation's existing school buses with clean and zero-emission (ZE) models — delivering cleaner air for communities across the country.



School buses transport **25 million+** American children **over 4 billion miles each year.**



Most school buses **release pollutants from diesel exhaust.** These pollutants from older buses can negatively impact air quality and human health, especially for children.

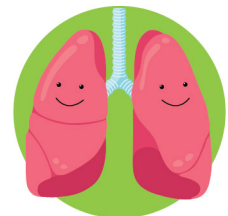
